- Holistic interventions
- Supported attendance at AA / NA Fellowship meetings
- Drug and Alcohol testing





We support men who are willing and ready to deal with their addiction in a safe and abstinent environment. Men can stay for up to two years.


TNP's programme is based on total abstinence from drugs and alcohol. Our programme empowers men in recovery to gain confidence and skills before moving towards training and employment.

We currently have 6 houses in South London and surrounding areas.
